## 9. Selection Criteria

Successful applicants should meet the following selection criteria:

- *Tuia 250 Voyage Trainees* must be physically fit and able to carry out the tasks required of their vessel.
- *Trainees* should not have medical conditions that are likely to cause harm to themselves or others under the conditions of being on-board a vessel.
- *Trainees* must be willing to obey the instructions of the captains and permanent crews of the vessels.
- *Trainees* will need to be available and willing to participate on the voyage leg they are assigned to.
- *Trainees* must be willing to participate in all aspects of the *Tuia 250 Voyage* programme, including pōhiri, the learning of waiata and karakia, and discussions and wānanga regarding *Tuia* kaupapa and themes.
- *Trainees* should have a passion and genuine interest in the *Tuia 250* kaupapa, themes and activities.
- *Trainees* should have an understanding of the *Tuia 250* kaupapa and themes.
- *Trainees* must be willing and able to share their experiences and learnings from the *Tuia 250 Voyage* with their communities, hapū and iwi in a creative and effective manner.

## 10. Photo, Video and Application Material Terms of Use
